The deadline for applications for a place in Year 7 at secondary school is 31st October, 2016. Applications can be made online at www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions.

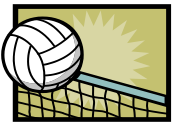

A long range strike from Rodrigo in the first half put us 1-0 up. Two further excellent saves from Freddie kept us in front, before George out muscled 2 defenders to snatch a second goal.
